

# Kita City Disaster Preparedness Map

## Legend

	<b>Evacuation site</b> A place to protect yourself from fire if a fire breaks out, fire to an evacuation site in the opposite direction of the fire. Large open areas, such as parks, riverbeds, and open spaces, are set as evacuation sites.		<b>First aid station</b> When a major disaster occurs, a first aid station is placed in some shelters. If necessary, it provides treatment for minor injuries and health-related consultations.
	<b>Evacuation site area</b>		<b>Temporary accommodation (for people who cannot return home)</b> A temporary shelter for people who have no place to stay (work, school, etc.) until they are able to return home after a disaster while away from home, such as at work.
	<b>Temporary gathering area</b> A place used for gathering when evacuating as a group. It is also used as a place to keep an eye on the disaster situation. Town councils and neighborhood associations independently designate small parks, vacant lots, and elementary and junior high schools as temporary gathering areas.		<b>Disaster water supply stations</b> Places at which Kita City will supply water in the event of a major disaster. Water for drinking is supplied.
	<b>Shelters (such as public elementary and junior high schools)</b> Places for residents to temporarily live when a disaster destroys or burns down their house, making it uninhabitable.		<b>Disaster water supply stations (deep well)</b> Places at which Kita City will supply water in the event of a major disaster. Water for living is supplied.
	<b>Parks, playgrounds, and green zones</b>		<b>Private shared wells (shallow wells)</b>
	<b>Sloped land</b>		<b>Municipal water tanks</b> Facilities that store water for putting out fires and for use in emergency toilets.
	<b>City Office (Disaster Response Headquarters)</b>		<b>Railroad (JR)</b>
	<b>Disaster Prevention Center</b>		<b>Subway</b>
	<b>Fire stations and branches</b>		<b>Toden Arakawa (Tramcar) Line</b>
	<b>Police stations and boxes</b>		<b>Expressways</b>
	<b>Disaster preparedness facilities</b>		<b>Roads designated by Kita City for return home support</b> These are roads designated by the City for people to return home on foot in the event of a disaster.
	<b>Emergency broadcast system speaker</b> Speakers that broadcast disaster-related information. Every evening, the speakers broadcast a "Sunset Chime."		<b>Roads designated by the Tokyo Metropolitan Government for return home support</b> These are roads designated by the Tokyo Metropolitan Government for people to return home on foot in the event of a disaster. The designated roads cross Tokyo and prefectural borders. Water and toilets are provided.
	<b>Emergency first aid station</b> When a major disaster occurs, an emergency first aid station is placed near a hospital, if necessary. Those with minor injuries are treated there, and those with serious injuries are sent to the hospital.		

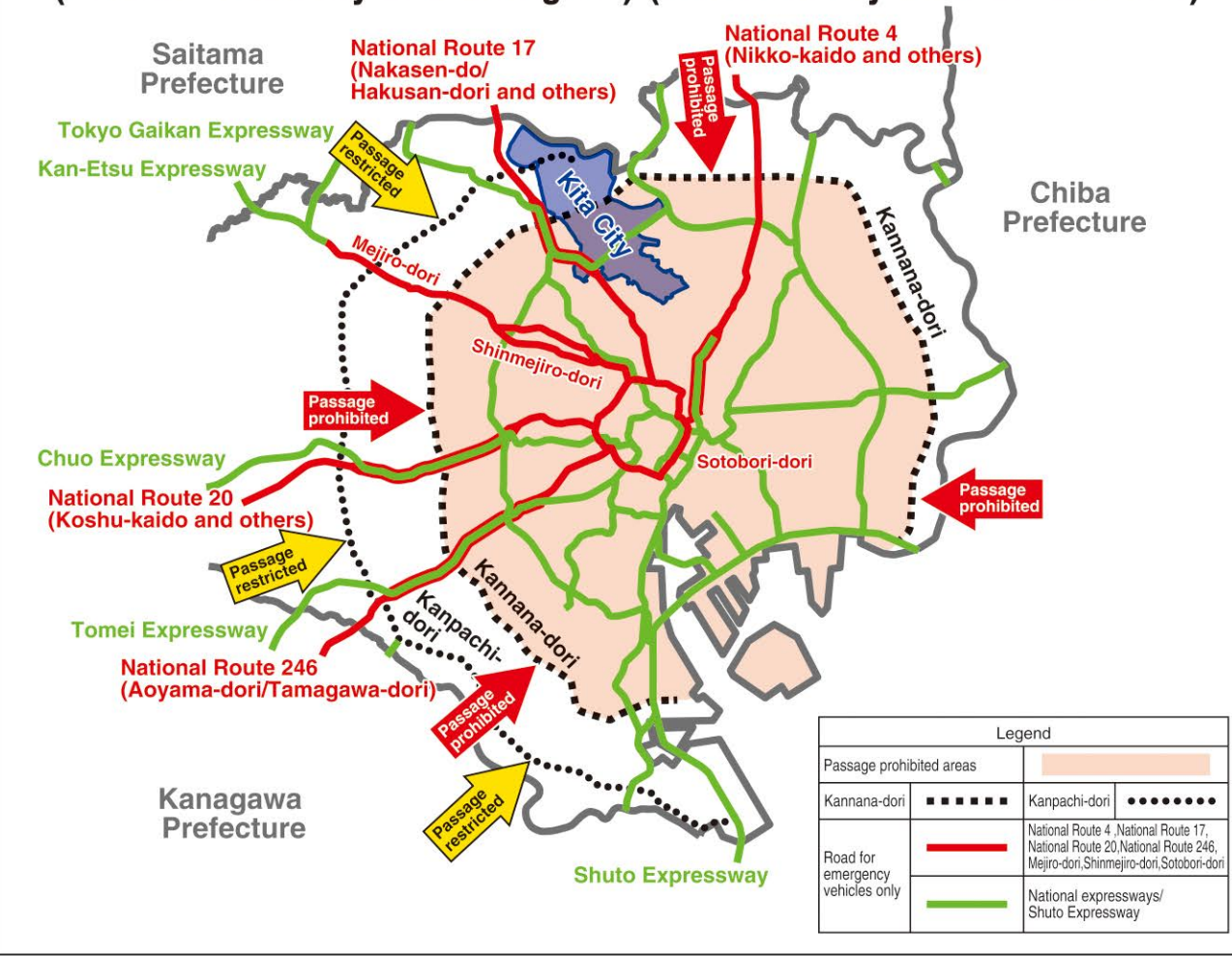

### Primary traffic restrictions in the event of a powerful earthquake (seismic intensity of 6 or higher) (immediately after occurrence)



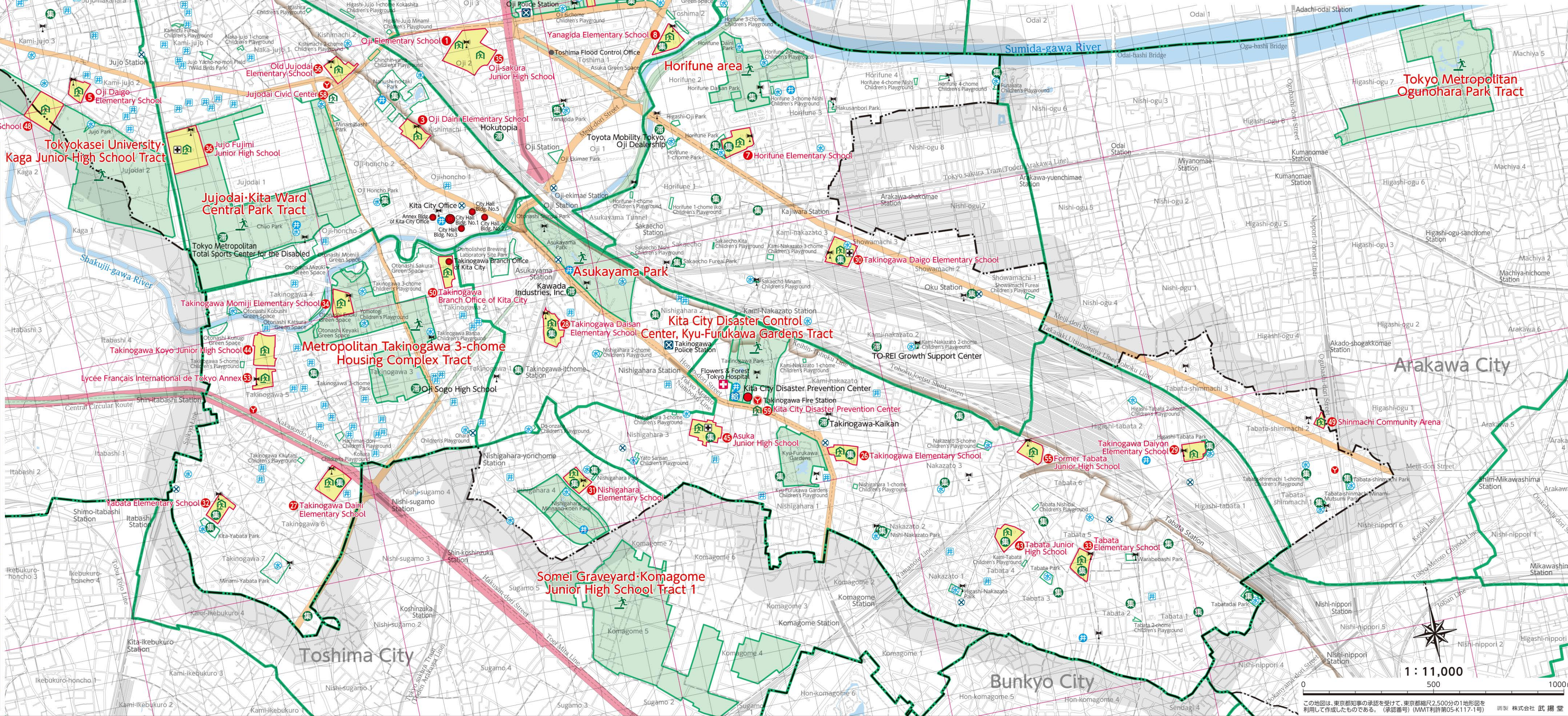
### How to use this map
