

# Separation and Disposal of Garbage and Recyclables in Kita City

**On the day of collection, please place your garbage / recyclables at the collection point by 8am.**

**Where to take out:**  
 ○Combustibles, Noncombustibles, Papers and Plastics→Collection point or Designated sites  
 ○Bottles, Cans, PET bottles→ Collection point for Bottles, Cans, PET bottles called "Station" or designated location

<h3>Residential Trash Rules</h3> <p>Under the Japanese law, any improper garbage and recycle disposals are prohibited. Violation of this will result in either imprisonment up to 5 years / fine up to JPY 10 million yen or both.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You must follow the trash schedule above, and place your trash and recyclables at the designated place by 8am.</li> <li>Sort out all disposals as per above schedule and instructions. Any trashes that are not sorted out cannot be picked up.</li> <li>To avoid any pick up mistakes, do not put any of your belongings near by the designated collection point.</li> <li>The amount of trash that can be taken out at one time is limited to four 45-liter trash bags.              If you are doing a major construction, renovation, or anything similar on going in your home, please contact to a waste collection office for trash removal service - which will charge you separately.</li> <li>You also need to call waste collection office for any pick up services of animal carcass - which will be charged separately.              (In case you find a carcass in a public road, please contact to the Roads and Parks department (03-3908-9265))</li> <li>When disposing any trashes for business use, please put a stickers of Kita city commercial paid tickets. please attach Kita city commercial paid trash tickets.</li> </ol>

② Then count the days of the week from the top.
