- Guidance for the New Adults

We will send the invitation cards during the beginning of December to the New  
Adults who are registered in Kita City as of 1<sup>st</sup> of December of 2022 (Reiwa 4<sup>th</sup>).

The New Adults who live in out of Kita City now, but who graduated from primary  
schools or Junior High Schools of Kita City can also participate in the ceremony,  
although invitation cards will not be dispatched. Please come to the ceremony hall  
directly in that case.

If Sakura Hall becomes full, the New Adults will be escorted to enter into Tsutsuji  
Hall. In principle, there are no seats for the parents.

- In respect of preventing the spread of infection COVID-19,

We will take the following measures:

1. We will avoid crowds by dividing the ceremony into two parts. Further, the people attending and leaving shall be dispersed in accordance with the school zones.
2. The number of the guests shall be limited. We used to invite all chiefs of the town block associations and of the residents' associations, but this time we will invite only the chiefs of 19 joint associations of the town block associations and the residents' associations).
3. We will exhaustively execute basic methods for prevention of infection. We will put alcohol-based hand sanitizers in front of the entrance for the hall. Please cooperate with disinfection of your hands. Further, please check your temperature at home and you are requested to stay home if the temperature is over 37.5 degree. Please wear a mask in the hall and to sit in every other seat.
4. We will transmit on-line ceremony (lively). In case you are not feeling well, you are requested to refrain from coming to the hall and watch the transmission at home.
5. The attraction (the party for the new adults) which had been held after the ceremony, shall not be held this time.
6. We will arrange some photo-spots outside of Hoku-Topia such as at the parks and the gardens in Kita City so that the new adults who missed the ceremony can take commemorative photos. We will also set some photo-spots when the ceremony will not be held.
