- Guidance for New Adults

We will send invitation cards during the beginning of December to New Adults who
are registered in Kita City as of 1st of December of 2020 (Reiwa 2nd).

New Adults who live in out of Kita City and graduated from primary schools or Junior
High Schools of Kita City can also participate in the Ceremony, although invitation
cards will not be dispatched and must come to the Ceremony Hall directly.

If Sakura Hall becomes full, then New Adults will enter into Tsutsuji Hall. In
principle, there is no sheet for parents.

- In respect of preventing the spread of infection COVID-19,

We will take following measures:

1. By dividing the ceremony into two parts, we will avoid crowding. Further, attending people and leaving people shall be dispersed in accordance with the school zones.
2. The number of guests shall be limited (Usually, we had invited all chiefs of town block associations and of residents' associations, but this time we will invite only chiefs of 19 joint associations of town block associations and residents' associations).
3. We will exhaustively execute basic methods for prevention of infection. In front of the entrance for the hall we put alcohol-based hand sanitizers. Then kindly use the sanitizers. Further, please measure your body temperature before arriving at the hall and you shall be requested to stay home if the temperature is over 37.5 degree. You are requested to wear medical mask in the hall and to sit in every other seat.
4. We will transmit on-line ceremony (lively). In case you feel bad, you are requested to refrain from coming to the hall and look at the transmission at home.
5. The attraction (New Adults Party) which usually had held, shall not be held this time.
